Dear Families:

Recently you received a letter from your principal outlining your school's accountability status under the No Child Left Behind Law.

Since your child's school receives Title I funds from the federal government, we are required to use 5% of our Title I funds to provide free outside tutoring (Supplemental Services) to eligible students in grades 4-8 at the Veterans and Belmonte Schools who receive free and reduced lunch. If there is not enough funding for every child requesting services, eligible students with the greatest academic need in math as determined by 2010 MCAS testing will receive first priority.

If you would like to apply for your child to receive these free tutoring services, please complete the "Student Enrollment Form" on the next page and return to your school's main office by November 15, 2010. You will then receive a letter from me letter you know if your child is eligible. If he/she is eligible, I will give you information on tutoring providers in the area and help you enter into an agreement with that provider. You would then be responsible for providing transportation for your child to each of these tutoring sessions.
