

Saugus School Building Assessment Committee Meeting Minutes

Date: Wednesday, December 15, 2004

Meeting convened: 7:04 p.m.

Meeting adjourned: 8:47 p.m.

Six members of the SSBAC, Chairman Roger Sacilotto, Vice-Chairman William Bean, Ed Carlson, Christopher Luongo, Brian Mirasolo, and Louis Rossi were present for the meeting. Steve Agganis, Kevin Nigro were not present.

- The meeting opened with Mr. Roger Sacilotto reviewing the previous SSBAC meeting for members.
- The discussion moved to the topic of surveys. The SSBAC has decided to craft surveys in order to obtain both professional and public opinion about existing and potential future school buildings in the town of Saugus. Members openly discussed specific formatting issues. SSBAC members present agreed that the SSBAC should create two surveys. One survey will address the conditions/needs of current and potential future school buildings. The other survey will address the local economic factors surrounding the construction of new school buildings.

Before adjourning the SSBAC agreed to look into the cost of mailing surveys out to the public. The SSBAC will next meet on Wednesday, January 5, 2005 at 7 p.m. at Town Hall.
